5. Full agreement with NVCCC's statement of faith, bylaws, and practices.
6. A passionate love for Christ, reflected in daily life and character.
7. A strong burden for evangelism and enthusiasm for making disciples of Christ.
8. Spiritual and emotional maturity.
9. Strong leadership, organizational, interpersonal, and teaching skills.
10. Ordained as a pastor.

Job Description

1. Lead English worship services, Sunday school, Bible studies, outreach programs, caring ministries, and fellowship activities for the English-speaking congregation.
2. Preach and teach in English worship services and Sunday school with a focus on life transformation in Christ, helping the congregation apply biblical principles in their daily lives.
3. Develop discipleship and training programs for English-speaking believers.
4. Collaborate with youth ministers to engage parents, families, youth, and other adults in fostering spiritual growth and faith development, building a Christ-centered community.
5. Equip and nurture the spiritual gifts of English congregation members to cultivate a heart of servanthood.
6. Support the overall mission, development, and direction of the Church.
7. Report to the Council of Elders and attend Board of Directors (BOD) meetings.
